We catalyze a deep sense of belonging among Latinos to strengthen the social networks that help people feel valued and connected.

We believe in building social capital, and networks of support that celebrate our heritage and culture, while building social connections that cross race, culture, and economic status. Recognizing that policies can further marginalize communities, we pair cultural engagement with direct services, so participant voices are engaged in catalyzing systemic change.
