Phlebotomy Certification

Phlebotomists collect blood samples from patients and send them off for analysis and testing. The average starting wage for a phlebotomist is \$17.97 per hour, and the job market is expected to increase 10% by 2031 (US Bureau of Labor Statistics, 2023)
